- The Golden Eagles close out the 2019 regular season this weekend when travel across the state to take on East Stroudsburg in a televised clash
  - This will be the 15th meeting between the two teams, with East Stroudsburg owning a 10-4 advantage in the all-time series with the Warriors
  - East Stroudsburg won last year's meeting, a 23-17 decision at Memorial Stadium
- The Golden Eagles are coming off a 57-10 loss at home to Mercyhurst, Clarion's final home game of the year
- Safety **Sam Fareri** recorded his first interception of the season last week, giving him 10 picks for his career, while lineman **Saif Khan** forced his team-leading third fumble of the year
- Running back **Mylique McGriff** reached 2,230 career rushing yards last week, and is within striking distance of cracking the top-five all-time at Clarion
  - McGriff leads the PSAC in rushing at 105.6 yards/game, and his 5.3 yards/carry average is fourth in the league among rushers with 100+ attempts
- Receiver **Quinn Zinobile** caught eight passes for 85 yards against Mercyhurst, and also returned four kicks for 137 yards
  - Zinobile now leads Clarion with 545 receiving yards and 13.0 yards per reception
- Wide receiver **Kahliq Muhammad** has seven receiving touchdowns this year, the most for a Golden Eagle since 2016
  - Muhammad was recently informed that he will have an additional year of eligibility in 2020
  - Clarion's 21 passing touchdowns this year are the most since posting 26 in 2016
- Kicker **James Metzgar** has made seven of his last nine field goal attempts, and needs two more makes to reach fourth all-time in Clarion history
  - Metzgar successfully converted his third first down of the season last week, completing a pass to Sam Fareri on a fake punt
  - Metzgar made headlines off the field last week when he proposed to his longtime girlfriend before kickoff against Mercyhurst
- Clarion has once again renewed its fruitful partnership with SportsFever and will have three games televised locally and streamed nationally on ESPN3 - 9/14 vs. Shippensburg, 10/26 at Slippery Rock and 11/9 vs. Mercyhurst

## CLARION FOOTBALL GAME NOTES - WEEK 11 VS EAST STROUDSBURG

### The Lead

The Clarion Golden Eagles will close the 2019 season this Saturday when they take on East Stroudsburg at Eiler-Martin Stadium at 1:05 p.m.

Mike Kalinowski and Joe Lodanosky will have the radio call for the game on 96.3 WKQW-FM an hour before kickoff. Live audio streaming will be available via the WKQW website and linked on the schedule at [ClarionGoldenEagles.com](http://ClarionGoldenEagles.com).

The game will be televised by Blue Ridge TV-113 and will stream on the PSAC Network app.

### Scouting The Warriors

The Warriors were predicted to finish sixth in the PSAC East preseason poll and actually did exactly that, recording a 5-5 overall record and a 2-5 mark in divisional play. East Stroudsburg came out of the gates firing by winning their first five games of the year, including monster offensive efforts against Lock Haven and Millersville, but have since lost five straight games. As far as common opponents with Clarion this year, East Stroudsburg owns wins over Seton Hill, Edinboro and the Bald Eagles, and lost to Shepherd and Shippensburg.

The Warriors are looking for their first six-win campaign since the 2015 season, and enter the week ranked sixth in the PSAC in scoring offense at 29.7 points per game. They have been proficient on special teams in recent weeks, with Jordan Walters and Rece Bender winning PSAC East Special Teams Player of the Week honors in back-to-back weeks earlier this year. Quarterback Jake Cirillo is a threat with his feet as well as his arm; he has a net 446 rushing yards and three ground scores to go with his 1,862 passing yards and 15 touchdown passes.

### Series History

This will be the 15th meeting between the Golden Eagles and the Warriors, with East Stroudsburg holding a 10-4 advantage in the all-time series. Famously, the two teams met in the PSAC Championship games in 1978 and 1983, splitting the two; the Warriors claimed the former by a score of 49-4, while the Golden Eagles won the latter 27-14. Clarion has not beaten East Stroudsburg since 2012.

The teams met in last year's season finale at Memorial Stadium, with the Warriors overcoming the harsh conditions for a 23-17 victory over the Golden Eagles. Scott Florence rushed for 111 yards, posted 48 receiving yards and ran it in for a score, while senior offensive lineman Rob Korzon caught a lateral for a touchdown. Quinlin Lambert was one of two Golden Eagles to force a turnover on defense, picking off a pass.

### About the Coach

Chris Weibel is in his fifth season as the program's head coach after spending many of the previous years as an assistant. Weibel has an overall record of 19-35 at Clarion, including an 11-24 record in PSAC West play. A 2010 inductee into the Clarion Sports Hall of Fame, Weibel graduated with every major Clarion passing record to his credit.

### Clarion Picked Seventh in Preseason Poll

### Last Week

The Clarion football team honored its seniors in a pregame ceremony on Saturday, but the Golden Eagles fell to Mercyhurst by a 57-10 score at Memorial Stadium.

The Lakers took early control of the contest and never allowed the Golden Eagles a foothold, with Clarion's first score coming just 47 seconds into the fourth quarter. Tight end Jake Whitenight caught his third touchdown pass of the season and James Metzgar added a field goal with 2:14 remaining in regulation to represent the Golden Eagles' scoring.

Metzgar enjoyed a couple of highlights on his Saturday. In addition to kicking the field goal, he also completed a pass to Sam Fareri on a fake punt in the first half to pick up a Clarion first down, making him 3-for-3 on converting fake punts into first downs this season.

Clarion's offense did not pick up much traction until the second half, doing most of their damage in the final 30 minutes of action. Quinn Zinobile had eight catches for 85 yards, while Kahlid Muhammad made a number of impressive sideline grabs in posting seven catches for 70 yards. Zinobile was pressed into duty as a kick returner and did well, averaging 34.3 yards per return.

On defense, Sam Fareri had a game-high 10 tackles and recorded his first interception of the year, thwarting a Laker drive by picking off a pass in the end zone. Saif Khan finished with seven tackles and a sack, while Chris Gildea had eight stops and a pass break-up.

### Grand Return

Myliques McGriff returned to the lineup on Nov. 2 after missing the previous three weeks to injury, posting 80 rushing yards and two rushing touchdowns against Edinboro. The junior running back jumped back to the top of the list of rushers in the PSAC in 2019, averaging 105.6 rushing yards per game in his seven games of action. Only one other rusher, Chantz Swartz of Lock Haven, is averaging better than 100 yards per game on the ground.

> McGriff moved into seventh place on the all-time rushing list at Clarion against Edinboro, and now has 2,230 rushing yards. There are still three former Golden Eagle rushers that are in his sights for this final game - Ron DeJidas (2,286), Alfonso Hoggard (2,350) and Eddie Emmanuel (2,371) are all within striking distance.

### Fall on the Ball

Through 10 weeks, Clarion ranks as one of the top teams not just in the PSAC but also in the nation in recovered fumbles. With recoveries by Sam Fareri and Dante Paul against Edinboro on Nov. 2, the Golden Eagles rank first in the PSAC and 17th in the nation with 11 fumble recoveries. Paul and Chris Gildea are tied for the team lead with two fumbles recovered each, a number that also leads the PSAC.

### Wells On His Way

Cornerback Corey Wells recorded his third interception of the season in the game against Edinboro on Nov. 2, and in the process set a new career high. He picked off two passes a season ago.

### Off the Schneid

Safety Sam Fareri has a history of being a ballhawk, but going into the 10th game of the season he had not yet recorded an interception. That changed against Mercyhurst last week, when Fareri intercepted a pass in the end zone for his first pick of the year.

### Bringing the Big Boot

James Metzgar ranked second in the PSAC in field goal percentage last year, making 10 of his 13 kicks for a 76.9 percent mark from long. His 10 makes ranked behind just IUP's Dillon Sarka and Slippery Rock's Jake Chapla. While not statistically the most proficient kicker in Clarion history - that would be Bill May, he of the program-record 49 makes from 1977-80 - another two conversions from Metzgar would give him 28 career field goals, good enough for fourth in program history.

> Metzgar has been on a roll over the last five games, making seven of his last nine field goal attempts with a long make of 37 yards. His longest field goal this year was a 42-yarder against Shepherd on Sept. 21.

### Don't Sleep On Him

James Metzgar has also shown the ability to give his team a boost with his ability to effectively pull off fakes on special teams plays. He has successfully converted three first downs from the punter position this year - two on runs and another on a completed pass to long snapper Sam Fareri.

**Wallace Gives, and Wallace Takes Away**

Leading the charge on the Clarion defense has been defensive end Vaughn Wallace. Wallace has been dominant upfront in general with a team-high 5.0 sacks and 7.5 tackles for loss. On Sept. 28 against Gannon, he recorded his first career defensive touchdown, stripping quarterback Jimmy Keefe of the ball on a sack and returning the loose ball 48 yards for a touchdown. He also leads the team with nine quarterback hurries.

> Wallace's defensive score was Clarion's second of the year, with the first coming on Trent Rogers' pick-six against Shippensburg in the season opener. Rogers' interception return was the first such score for Clarion since Jacob Craig returned a pick for a score against Cheyney on Sept. 19, 2015. That year was also the last time Clarion scored two defensive touchdowns in a season, with Craig's interception return for a touchdown and Andrew Fragale's fumble recovery for a touchdown coming in that same game.

**Tops for Tight Ends**

Jake Whitenight came to Clarion as an offensive lineman but has made the move to tight end, and in just 10 games has already earned an unexpected distinction. Whitenight caught his third touchdown pass of the year on Nov. 9 against Mercyhurst, making him the first Golden Eagle tight end to catch three scores in a season in five years. The last to do it was Zach Deitrick, who caught four scores in 2014.

**The Mighty Quinn**

Quinn Zinobile continued his ascendancy in the team's receiver ranks against Mercyhurst, posting eight catches for 85 yards. He moved into first on the roster in receiving yards (545), as well as second in receptions (42) and touchdown catches (3). He also showed ability as a kick returner against the Lakers, taking back four kicks for 137 yards. That included a long return of 53 yards, and he ultimately ended up with 222 all-purpose yards against Mercyhurst.

**Muhammad Takes the Reins**

Kahliq Muhammad has been one of the Golden Eagles' lead performers in the passing game, with the senior receiver taking the lead in the major receiving categories for the Golden Eagles. Muhammad leads the team with 38 catches for 474 yards and seven touchdowns. His 38 catches through nine games is already the most for a Clarion player since Kevin Genevro and Matt Lehman had 65 and 51 receptions, respectively, in the 2016 season, and his seven scores are the most since Genevro's 13 and Lehman's eight that season.

> Muhammad had his best game to date in a Clarion uniform in a 42-16 win over Seton Hill, setting season-highs in catches (7), receiving yards (94) and touchdowns (3). He became the first Golden Eagle to catch three touchdown passes in a single game since Mason Standard hauled in three scoring grabs against the Griffins on Oct. 7, 2017.

**Double Trouble**

The receiving duo of Quinn Zinobile and Terrell Ford both caught a pair of touchdown passes against Lock Haven, marking the first scores in the Blue & Gold for both receivers. While Clarion has had a recent history of strong depth at receiver, it has actually been nearly four years since two players *both* caught multiple touchdown passes in the same game. For that, you have to go back to Oct. 10, 2015, when Matt Lehman and Kevin Genevro both hauled in two scores against Edinboro.

**Flying Around the Field**

Chris Gildea had a career-high 16 tackles against IUP on Oct. 19, marking the first game of 15+ tackles for a Golden Eagle this season. It's the most tackles in a game for Clarion since Layne Skundrich notched 17 stops against Cal U on Oct. 6, 2018. Sam Fareri also got in on the action with 15 stops against the Crimson Hawks. Fareri now leads the team with 77 total tackles on the season.

**Yoink!**

Last year the Golden Eagles were one of the top teams not just in the conference but in the nation at picking off passes. With 18 total interceptions in 2018, Clarion ranked eighth in NCAA Division II and third in the PSAC. Their 27 forced turnovers ranked 11th in the country and third in the PSAC, and their turnover margin of +0.55 ranked fourth in the league.

Clarion's trend of taking the ball away from opponents has continued in 2019. The Golden Eagles have forced 21 turnovers through 10 games this year, a number that ranks fifth in the PSAC.

**Paving the Road**

Clarion rushed for 341 yards as a team against Shippensburg on Sept. 9, recording an impressive 7.1 yards per carry and including four rushing touchdowns – three by Myliques McGriff and the first career score for Ross Greece. It is the best single-game rushing total for the Golden Eagles since Oct. 8, 2011, when they went off for 423 rushing yards at home against Lock Haven.

**Built Ford Tough**

Against Seton Hill on Oct. 5, Terrell Ford became the first Golden Eagle to return a kickoff for a touchdown in nearly a decade when he blazed down the field for a 90-yard score against the Griffins. While several Clarion players have scored on punt returns for touchdowns in recent years, the last one to take a kickoff back was Patrick Graham-Murphy, who returned a kick for a score against Shippensburg during the 2011 season. He is one of only 42 players in the country to return a kick for a touchdown this year, and one of only three players in the PSAC to do so.

**Lights, Camera, Action!**

Clarion University will continue its fruitful partnership with the Pennsylvania Sports Fever Television Network in 2019, with three contests – 9/14 vs. Lock Haven, 10/26 at Slippery Rock and 11/9 vs. Mercyhurst – airing live on affiliates across the state of Pennsylvania and made available to millions in the Keystone State. The selected games will also be streamed on ESPN3 via the Watch ESPN app.

# CHRIS WEIBEL

Clarion, 1998

Fifth Year • 19-35 Overall Record • 11-24 PSAC West Record

Chris Weibel, a former All-America quarterback at Clarion, enters his fifth season as head coach of the Golden Eagle football program. A former professional quarterback and 2010 inductee into Clarion's Sports Hall of Fame, he served an assistant coach for the Golden Eagles for 11 seasons before becoming Clarion's 12th head football coach on February 6, 2015.

The Golden Eagles have flourished under Weibel, especially at the individual level. Clarion has boasted 19 All-PSAC West players since 2015, including four First Teamers and 15 Second Teamers. Brandon Vocco earned Don Hansen Football Gazette All-America Honorable Mention honors in 2018, making him the first Golden Eagles to earn a spot in the publication's honorees since wide receiver Kevin Genevro was a Third Team All-American in 2016. Wide receiver Matt Lehman was the same in 2015, and offensive lineman Zack Morris was a two-time an All-Super Region 1 selection by the same publication in both 2016 and 2017.

Clarion has excelled in the classroom in that same timeframe, as well. The Golden Eagles have had four CoSIDA Academic All-Americans since 2015, including Matt Koerper (2015), Kevin Genevro (2016), Jacob Craig (2016) and Sam Fareri (2018).

The 2018 Golden Eagles got off to a hot start, winning four of their first five games and boasting a dominant defense until injuries took their toll throughout the season. They finished sixth in the PSAC West with a record of 2-5, winning their first two divisional games against Gannon and Seton Hill. Brandon Vocco was named a First Team All-PSAC selection and went on to earn all-district and Don Hansen Football Gazette All-America Honorable Mention honors. He was joined on the all-conference squad by linebacker Layne Skundrich, offensive lineman Zack Morris, and fellow defensive linemen Saif Khan and Alec Heldreth. Heldreth earned an invite to the Atlanta Falcons' rookie minicamp after showing well at the PSAC Pro Day in spring 2019.

In 2016, Weibel guided a Golden Eagle squad decimated by injury, rallying the team to wins in two of their final three games for a 4-7 overall record. Clarion defeated Slippery Rock for the first time since the 2010 season and their first in the "Milk Jug" rivalry series. Quarterback Connor Simmons broke the program's all-time passing touchdown record - set by Weibel - with his 66th scoring pass in the win over Gannon, and receiver Matt Lehman tied the program record for career receiving touchdowns with his 25th career score in the same game.

Senior receiver Kevin Genevro hauled in a bevy of accolades in 2016, earning First Team All-PSAC West and Don Hansen Football Gazette Third Team All-American honors. He became just the third player in program history to top 1,000 yards receiving in a season and finished at or near the top of several other all-time lists. He was joined on the All-PSAC West list by punter Scott Ayers (First Team), offensive lineman Zack Morris (First Team), and Lehman (Second Team).

Clarion players excelled in the classroom as well, with Genevro leading the charge. He and linebacker Jacob Craig were both named CoSIDA Academic All-Americans.

Clarion was picked to finish eighth in the PSAC West in 2015, but Weibel shocked the conference by leading Clarion to seven straight wins to open the slate. It was the first time the Golden Eagles opened a season with seven straight wins since 1983. Clarion finished the year with a 7-4 record and four All-PSAC West selections, including First Team selection Matt Lehman (wide receiver) and Second Team nods Phil Esposito (kicker), Matt Koerper (defensive end) and Delrece Williams (running back).

Lehman went on to earn Don Hansen Third Team All-America honors at the end of the year, while Connor Simmons ranked fourth in the nation in passing yards and broke Weibel's Clarion single-season record for passing yards (3,582) and passing touchdowns (34).

Weibel came to Clarion in 1993 and had a storied career with the Golden Eagles. As a true freshman in 1993 he played in three games, started two, and completed 21 of 44 passes for 280 yards and three touchdowns. He redshirted 1994, and came back in 1995 to lead Clarion to a 6-4 record while hitting on 159 of 268 passes (59.3 percent) for 2,017 yards and 14 touchdowns.

His best season came in 1996 when he led the Golden Eagles to an 11-3 overall record, the PSAC-West title, the NCAA Division II East Region Crown and a berth in the NCAA "Final Four" before losing in the final seconds to Northern Colorado. Weibel earned NCAA D-II All-America honors, completing 208 of 356 passes (58.4 percent) for 2,880 yards and 32 touchdowns. He ranked second in the nation in 1996 in Quarterback Efficiency while also running for 185 yards and four touchdowns. Clarion was awarded the Lambert Cup, signifying the top team in the East.

Headed for a big season his senior year (1997), Weibel played the first five quarters before missing the remainder of the season with an injury. He came back in 1998 to pass for 2,462 yards and 16 touchdowns.

Weibel at one time held all four key career passing records at Clarion including passing attempts (1,065), completions (586), passing yards (7,845). He now ranks second in passing touchdowns with 65 total scoring tosses. His career completion percentage is 55 percent, third best in Eagle history. He also set the records for single season passing yards (2,880 - 1996) and touchdown passes (32 - 1996) which were not surpassed until the 2015 season.

After graduating from Clarion in 1998 with a degree in Marketing, he played nearly five years of professional football including the Erie Invaders (IFL) in 2000, Florida Firecats (AFL 2) in 2001, Greensboro Prowlers (AFL 2) in 2002, Myrtle Beach Sting Rays (NIFL) in 2003 and signed during the 2004 season with Grand Rapids of the AFL. During the 2002 season he had his best game, completing 23 of 25 passes for 330 yards and nine touchdowns.
