- The PSAC's top rushing offense will try to match one of the league's best passing attacks as the Golden Eagles host the Shepherd Rams at Memorial Stadium on Saturday
 - This will be just the third meeting between the now-PSAC rivals, with the Rams owning a 2-0 advantage in the all-time series with the Golden Eagles
 - Clarion and Shepherd have not met since playing in back-to-back years in 1998-99
- The Golden Eagles are coming off a 48-20 win over Lock Haven, marking Clarion's first 2-0 start to a season since a 7-0 beginning in 2015
 - Clarion quarterbacks combined for six touchdown passes against the Bald Eagles, the most in a single game since before 1999 and believed to be the most since a six-touchdown performance in 1992
 - Receivers Terrell Ford and Quinn Zinobile both caught a pair of touchdown passes, the first time two Golden Eagles had multiple touchdown receptions in the same game since 2015
- Clarion's rushing offense averages a PSAC-best 277.5 yards per game average, a mark that ranks 12th in the nation, and the Golden Eagles rank third in the conference in total offense at 487.5 yards per game
- Kicker/punter James Metzgar was named the PSAC West Special Teams Athlete of the Week for Sept. 16 after a standout performance against Lock Haven
- Running back Mylique McGriff leads the PSAC with 299 total rushing yards and three touchdowns, and is averaging 6.8 yards per carry
 - Fellow running back Ross Greece has now scored two touchdowns in as many games, tying him for fifth in the conference with a pair of rushing scores
- The Golden Eagles' 48-point effort marked the first back-to-back 40-point days since 2015, when they got Gannon and Mercyhurst for 40+ in consecutive weeks
- Senior safety Sam Fareri forced his first turnover of the season against Lock Haven, popping the ball out for his fifth career forced fumble
 - Fareri needs one more forced fumble to tie for fifth all-time in program history
- Clarion's defense ranks third in the conference with seven sacks, led by **Vaughn Wallace's** 2.0 sacks

Double Trouble

The receiving duo of Quinn Zinobile and Terrell Ford both caught a pair of touchdown passes In a coaches' poll before the start of the year, Clarion was predicted to finish seventh in the PSAC against Lock Haven, marking the first scores in the Blue & Gold for both receivers. While Clarion has had a recent history of strong depth at receiver, it has actually been nearly four years since two players both caught multiple touchdown passes in the same game. For that you have to go back to Oct. 10, 2015, when Matt Lehman and Kevin Genevro both hauled in two scores against Edinboro.

> > Through two games this year, five of Ford's seven receptions have gone for first downs, and two receptions have gone for touchdowns. As for Zinobile, his 66-yard reception against Lock Haven was the longest for a Golden Eagle since Dana Jackson, Jr.'s 68-yard receiving touchdown on Oct. 6, 2018 against Cal U.

> > Clarion has already had six different players catch touchdowns through two games. Last year only six different players in total caught touchdown passes.

Bringing the Big Boot

Kicker/punter James Metzgar was named the PSAC West Special Teams Athlete of the Week for Sept. 16. after using his feet to contribute to Clarion's win over Lock Haven in more ways than one. The senior went 5-of-6 on extra points and also added three punts for an average of 40.0 yards per kick, including one planted inside the 20-yard line. His most exciting play of the day came late in the game, when a breakdown forced Metzgar to evade a tackler in the backfield and go on the run. He eluded tacklers and went off for a 28-yard rush to give Clarion a first down. The Golden Eagles scored a touchdown on the very next play.

> Metzgar ranked second in the PSAC in field goal percentage last year, making 10 of his 13 kicks It was déjà vu all over again for Clarion football on Saturday afternoon, as the Golden Eagles for a 76.9 percent mark from long. His 10 makes ranked behind just IUP's Dillon Sarka and Slipopened up a big lead and piled on late for the second straight week, this time defeating Lock pery Rock's Jake Chapla. While not statistically the most proficient kicker in Clarion history – that would be Bill May, he of the program-record 49 makes from 1977-80 - another 10 conversions from Metzgar would give him 28 career field goals, good enough for fourth in program history.

Linebacker Trent Rogers intercepted Brycen Mussina and returned the pick for a touchdown at Tanner Jones added a touchdown pass in the fourth quarter, hitting Maverick Kelsea for a score the end of the first half of Clarion's win over Shippensburg on Sept. 7, marking the first Clarion defensive touchdown of the year and snapping a years-long pick-six drought. The Golden Eagles' last defensive touchdown came last year in a win over Gannon, when defensive lineman Alec Heldreth recovered a fumble in the end zone. Rogers' interception return was the first such score for Clarion since Jacob Craig returned a pick for a score against Cheyney on Sept. 19, 2015.

Yoink!

Last year the Golden Eagles were one of the top teams not just in the conference but in the nation at picking off passes. With 18 total interceptions in 2018, Clarion ranked eighth in NCAA Division II and third in the PSAC. Their 27 forced turnovers ranked 11th in the country and third in the PSAC, and their turnover margin of +0.55 ranked fourth in the league.

Clarion's trend of taking the ball away from opponents has continued in 2019. The Golden Eagles have forced five turnovers through two games this year, including three forced fumbles on defense

> Of the eight players to record interceptions for the Golden Eagles last year, Clarion returns six of them, including leader Sam Fareri (4). As such, the Golden Eagles "return" 12 of the 18 picks from a season ago.

Paving the Road

The Golden Eagles rank as the top rushing team in the PSAC through two games, averaging 277.5 rushing yards per game in wins over Shippensburg and Lock Haven. That also ranks 12th in the nation through two weeks. Clarion has also totaled five rushing touchdowns in those two games, one behind West Chester for the PSAC lead.

> Clarion rushed for 341 yards as a team against Shippensburg on Sept. 9, recording an impressive 7.1 yards per carry and including four rushing touchdowns – three by Mylique McGriff and the first career score for Ross Greece. It is the best single-game rushing total for the Golden Eagles since Oct. 8, 2011, when they went off for 423 rushing yards at home against Lock Haven.

Lighting It Up

Through two games the Clarion offense has been difficult to stop, at least as far as putting points up on the scoreboard. The Golden Eagles scored 48 points each against Shippensburg and Lock Haven in the first two weeks of the year, their first back-to-back 40-point performances since scoring 47 and 41 points, respectively, in back-to-back weeks against Gannon and Mercyhurst during the 2015 season. Clarion also scored a program-record 59 points against Cheyney before the former.

> Clarion's 48 points scored against Shippensburg on Sept. 9 represented the first time they had cracked 40 points against a PSAC opponent since dropping 41 points on Gannon in the 2016 season, and was their highest single-game scoring output since a 59-6 win against Cheyney during the 2015 season. The last time they scored 48 or more points against a current PSAC school was the year before, during a 55-16 win over Millersville.

Ball Hawk

Now in his fourth season, Sam Fareri has been a major factor in creating turnovers throughout his college career. With four interceptions and two forced fumbles last season, he has now accounted for 14 total turnovers in his career, including nine picks and five forced fumbles. He needs just three more interceptions to crack the top-six in program history, tying him with Kim Niedbala's total of 12 set from 1993-96. One more forced fumble would tie him with Niedbala and four others for seventh in program history.

> Fareri was named a Google Cloud Academic All-American in 2018, making in the fourth Golden Eagle in as many years to earn a spot on the team.

Wrath of Khan

Though the Golden Eagles lost a number of all-conference performers from a year ago, they did bring back one of their All-PSAC West contributors from 2018 in senior defensive lineman Saif Khan. Khan finished the 2018 season with 52 total tackles, third amongst all defensive linemen on the team, and added 5.5 tackles for loss and 3.5 total sacks.

Controlling the Skies

In 2018, the Golden Eagles were generally speaking one of the toughest teams to beat through the air in the conference. Clarion held opponents to just a 49.7 completion percentage on the season, the best mark in the PSAC, and their 191.5 passing yards allowed per game ranked behind just Cal U and Millersville.

Missing the Point(s)

In addition to the other accolades for the Golden Eagle defense last year, they were also adept at keeping opposing teams off the scoreboard. The Golden Eagles ranked third in the conference in scoring defense with 21.1 points allowed per game, with only two teams - Shippensburg and California - scoring more than 30 points against them all year long.

> Clarion ranked fourth in the conference in total defense at 336.4 yards allowed per game.

CHRIS WEIBEL Clarion, 1998

Fourth Year • 18-28 Overall Record • 10-18 PSAC West Record

Chris Weibel, a former All-America quarterback at Clarion, enters his fifth season as head coach of the Golden Eagle football program. A former professional quarterback and 2010 inductee into Clarion's Sports Hall of Fame, he served an assistant coach for the Golden Eagles for 11 seasons before becoming Clarion's 12th head football coach on February 6, 2015.

The Golden Eagles have flourished under Weibel, especially at the individual level. Clarion has boasted 19 All-PSAC West players since 2015, including four First Teamers and 15 Second Teamers. Brandon Vocco earned Don Hansen Football Gazette All-America Honorable Mention honors in 2018, making him the first Golden Eagles to earn a spot in the publication's honorees since wide receiver Kevin Genevro was a Third Team All-American in 2016. Wide receiver Matt Lehman was the same in 2015, and offensive lineman Zack Morris was a two-time an All-Super Region 1 selection by the same publication in both 2016 and 2017.

Clarion has excelled in the classroom in that same time-frame, as well. The Golden Eagles have had four CoSIDA Academic All-Americans since 2015, including Matt Koerper (2015), Kevin Genevro (2016), Jacob Craig (2016) and Sam Fareri (2018).

The 2018 Golden Eagles got off to a hot start, winning four of their first five games and boasting a dominant defense until injuries took their toll throughout the season. They finished sixth in the PSAC West with a record of 2-5, winning their first two divisional games against Gannon and Seton Hill. Brandon Vocco was named a First Team All-PSAC selection and went on to earn all-district and Don Hansen Football Gazette All-America Honorable Mention honors. He was joined on the all-conference squad by linebacker Layne Skundrich, offensive lineman Zack Morris, and fellow defensive linemen Saif Khan and Alec Heldreth. Heldreth earned an invite to the Atlanta Falcons' rookie minicamp after showing well at the PSAC Pro Day in spring 2019.

In 2016, Weibel guided a Golden Eagle squad decimated by injury, rallying the team to wins in two of their final three games for a 4-7 overall record. Clarion defeated Slippery Rock for the first time since the 2010 season and their first in the "Milk Jug" rivalry series. Quarterback Connor Simmons broke the program's all-time passing touchdown record - set by Weibel - with his 66th scoring pass in the win over Gannon, and receiver Matt Lehman tied the program record for career receiving touchdowns with his 25th career score in the same game.

Senior receiver Kevin Genevro hauled in a bevy of accolades in 2016, earning First Team All-PSAC West and Don Hansen Football Gazette Third Team All-American honors. He became just the third player in program history to top 1,000 yards receiving in a season and finished at or near the top of several other all-time lists. He was joined on the All-PSAC West list by punter Scott Ayers (First Team), offensive lineman Zack Morris (First Team), and Lehman (Second Team).

Clarion players excelled in the classroom as well, with Genevro leading the charge. He and linebacker Jacob Craig were both named CoSIDA Academic All-Americans.

Clarion was picked to finish eighth in the PSAC West in 2015, but Weibel shocked the conference by leading Clarion to seven straight wins to open the slate. It was the first time the Golden Eagles opened a season with seven straight wins since 1983. Clarion finished the year with a 7-4 record and four All-PSAC West selections, including First Team selection Matt Lehman (wide receiver) and Second Team nods Phil Esposito (kicker), Matt Koerper (defensive end) and Delrece Williams (running back).

Lehman went on to earn Don Hansen Third Team All-America honors at the end of the year, while Connor Simmons ranked fourth in the nation in passing yards and broke Weibel's Clarion single-season record for passing yards (3,582) and passing touchdowns (34).

Weibel came to Clarion in 1993 and had a storied career with the Golden Eagles. As a true freshman in 1993 he played in three games, started two, and completed 21 of 44 passes for 280 yards and three touchdowns. He redshirted 1994, and came back in 1995 to lead Clarion to a 6-4 record while hitting on 159 of 268 passes (59.3 percent) for 2,017 yards and 14 touchdowns.

His best season came in 1996 when he led the Golden Eagles to an 11-3 overall record, the PSAC-West title, the NCAA Division II East Region Crown and a berth in the NCAA "Final Four" before losing in the final seconds to Northern Colorado. Weibel earned NCAA D-II All-America honors, completing 208 of 356 passes (58.4 percent) for 2,880 yards and 32 touchdowns. He ranked second in the nation in 1996 in Quarterback Efficiency while also running for 185 yards and four touchdowns. Clarion was awarded the Lambert Cup, signifying the top team in the East.

Headed for a big season his senior year (1997), Weibel played the first five quarters before missing the remainder of the season with an injury. He came back in 1998 to pass for 2,462 yards and 16 touchdowns.

Weibel at one time held all four key career passing records at Clarion including passing attempts (1,065), completions (586), passing yards (7,845). He now ranks second in passing touchdowns with 65 total scoring tosses. His career completion percentage is 55 percent, third best in Eagle history. He also set the records for single season passing yards (2,880 – 1996) and touchdown passes (32 – 1996) which were not surpassed until the 2015 season.

After graduating from Clarion in 1998 with a degree in Marketing, he played nearly five years of professional football including the Erie Invaders (IFL) in 2000, Florida Firecats (AFL 2) in 2001, Greensboro Prowlers (AFL 2) in 2002, Myrtle Beach Sting Rays (NIFL) in 2003 and signed during the 2004 season with Grand Rapids of the AFL. During the 2002 season he had his best game, completing 23 of 25 passes for 330 yards and nine touchdowns.
